

Vaccines for Adults

Vaccines are not just kid stuff. Over time, the protection provided by childhood vaccines can weaken, and you may need protection against new or different diseases. It's important for adults to keep up to date on vaccines to stay healthy. By staying vaccinated, you also minimize the spread of diseases, which helps protect other people who might have a harder time fighting illness, like young children, older adults, and people with medical conditions.
